Money motion #2 (tabled from last region)

C + C

To increase the funding of PCRCNA by \$1,000 to a cap of \$5,200
(7-2-2) failed - (needed a 2/3 majority)

Bylaw motion #1:

To increase the definition of a major money motion to \$1,500.

Major motion #5: amend treasurers guidelines

To project a budget from previous year's revenue that shows prior years revenue to accompany the annual regional budget proposal.
(12-0-0, passed)

Major motion #6:

Any money motion of \$1,500 or more should be returned to the areas for approval.
(8-2-2, passed)

Major motion #7: Alan M. (C + C chair)

To have region clarify a procedure - What should C + C do when 2 or more areas intend to bid for the same RSC, assembly, or convention. (Deemed out of order) should be decided in committee.

Major motion #8: to implement #5 in Winter RSC (passed)

Money motion #3: to reimburse Denise for copies made \$90 (passed)

Money motion #4: to reimburse Donna for hotel \$89 to help out the treasurer. (Passed)

Major motion #9: budget passed (11-0-1)
