This is the report that was sent to other committee members about our business meeting. It was held yesterday, Friday 11/27/20 at 4pm on Zoom. This report was written by our Vice Chair Rachel A. The comments that are in parenthesis throughout the report is from our Chair Candace D. stating things that happened throughout the month to let everyone know so there is no confusion.

So I went onto Lit meeting so we were there available if anyone came with questions, interest, etc. Marybeth asked if I needed her to show up and I told her I was fine just chillin.

-Myk showed up, and we discussed the two main things I saw in your email, Candace. First I said we would be shortening our winter hours to 11-2 (this was also what Marybeth had suggested so I used that time) and when people arrived, we would be either there at parking lot level or down at the bottom of stairs, depending on weather.

(I have already done 11-2pm at the last week's pick because I already addressed it at the PASC meeting last month. They came down to the bottom of the basement stairs to receive their orders. That has already been happening for a few months now.

l told Myk he should let it be clear that if they see no one in a lot, to go look at the bottom of the stairs, where we would be with a table at that door.

(I will provide us with a good heater, and an extension cord if needed- this month l was still just over 2 weeks post-op so not driving yet. I am very sorry Candace that l did not at that time make

sure that you knew why l was not there. Thank you so much for being our representative that cold day!) Of course we can stay at the bottom of the stairs and we can change the above instructions.

Second, I told him that he needed to somehow bold the monthly times of ordering and picking up, as people were not showing up to get their orders and nor ordering in a timely manner to ensure they would be there. Marybeth mentioned that people still thought Lit was the same day of PASC . I told him people were more likely to see it within the page if it were bigger and/or bold (we have been explaining the new times for months and it states it right at the beginning of the page before ordering and we did that so everyone knew we changed the day and time). He then mentioned that he had created a data entry page for anyone starting up a new meeting, and that there was a button to press at bottom that said 'to start your meeting.'

I said it needed to be more clear to people that this button needed to be pressed in order to submit this info to Area; much in the same way as we had set it up for orders (Myk created this so we would know when there is a new meeting to get a starter kit to them, but we need to make sure when they hit that button that it goes to the orders email for literature the scheduler and the treasurer of area).

After a discussion he said for now he would relay those pages to the orders email for Literature. I let him know that for now l would be a point person until someone else stepped in as l know both subcommittees as well as the structure of Area.

It was important to me that as soon as he put that page on-site, there should be a connection. We can always change the person and/or the email relay, just as long as they have someone to connect with, for question, new kits if they need them and meeting info to put on the website. The Literature subcommittee does not want anyone to be left hanging- 5th tradition needs to be the main purpose.

So we ended the meeting at about 4:45, having discussed what we had, and knowing that it was a holiday weekend. I am really glad to be able to say that we did have our business meeting \clubsuit
